Anders Mol / Christian Sorum (NOR)	Have a career 137-30 (82.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 84-9 (90.3%) record in 2019-21. They are 114-11 (91.2%) when winning the 1st set, with 101 wins by sweeps and 13 in three sets. They are 21-19 (52.5%) when losing the 1st set, with 12 losses by sweeps and 7 in three sets.
Viacheslav Krasilnikov / Oleg Stoyanovskiy (ROC)	Have a career 75-24 (75.8%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 75-24 (75.8%) record in 2019-21. They are 62-7 (89.9%) when winning the 1st set, with 54 wins by sweeps and 8 in three sets. They are 13-17 (43.3%) when losing the 1st set, with 11 losses by sweeps and 6 in three sets.
Cherif Samba / Ahmed Tijan (QAT)	Have a career 100-56 (64.1%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 65-34 (65.7%) record in 2019-21. They are 82-17 (82.8%) when winning the 1st set, with 71 wins by sweeps and 11 in three sets. They are 18-39 (31.6%) when losing the 1st set, with 33 losses by sweeps and 6 in three sets.
Alison Cerutti / Alvaro Filho (BRA)	Have a career 62-28 (68.9%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 62-28 (68.9%) record in 2019-21. They are 53-6 (89.8%) when winning the 1st set, with 42 wins by sweeps and 11 in three sets. They are 9-22 (29.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 18 losses by sweeps and 4 in three sets.
Michal Bryl / Grzegorz Fijalek (POL)	Have a career 98-55 (64.1%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 51-25 (67.1%) record in 2019-21. They are 75-11 (87.2%) when winning the 1st set, with 58 wins by sweeps and 17 in three sets. They are 23-43 (34.8%) when losing the 1st set, with 36 losses by sweeps and 7 in three sets.
Yusuke "Gottsu" Ishijima / Katsuhiro Shiratori (JPN)	Have a career 3-9 (25.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 3-9 (25.0%) record in 2019-21. They are 3-3 (50.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 3 wins by sweeps and 0 in three sets. They are 0-6 (0.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 6 losses by sweeps and 0 in three sets.
Julius Thole / Clemens Wickler (GER)	Have a career 70-42 (62.5%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 38-21 (64.4%) record in 2019-21. They are 59-16 (78.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 51 wins by sweeps and 8 in three sets. They are 9-24 (27.3%) when losing the 1st set, with 19 losses by sweeps and 5 in three sets.
Evandro Goncalves / Bruno Oscar Schmidt (BRA)	Have a career 49-22 (69.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 49-22 (69.0%) record in 2019-21. They are 39-6 (86.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 34 wins by sweeps and 5 in three sets. They are 10-16 (38.5%) when losing the 1st set, with 14 losses by sweeps and 2 in three sets.

Alexander Brouwer / Robert Meeuwsen (NED)	Have a career 305-163 (65.2%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 56-32 (63.6%) record in 2019-21. They are 252-44 (85.1%) when winning the 1st set, with 208 wins by sweeps and 44 in three sets. They are 45-115 (28.1%) when losing the 1st set, with 81 losses by sweeps and 34 in three sets.
Tri Bourne / Jake Gibb (USA)	Have never played before on the FIVB World Tour.
Ondrej Perusic / David Schweiner (CZE)	Have a career 87-57 (60.4%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 47-27 (63.5%) record in 2019-21. They are 70-14 (83.3%) when winning the 1st set, with 49 wins by sweeps and 21 in three sets. They are 16-43 (27.1%) when losing the 1st set, with 32 losses by sweeps and 11 in three sets.
Ilya Leshukov / Konstantin Semenov (ROC)	Have a career 74-40 (64.9%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 47-27 (63.5%) record in 2019-21. They are 59-6 (90.8%) when winning the 1st set, with 52 wins by sweeps and 7 in three sets. They are 13-34 (27.7%) when losing the 1st set, with 25 losses by sweeps and 9 in three sets.
Adrian Gavira / Pablo Herrera (ESP)	Have a career 384-216 (64.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 42-31 (57.5%) record in 2019-21. They are 316-52 (85.9%) when winning the 1st set, with 246 wins by sweeps and 70 in three sets. They are 63-159 (28.4%) when losing the 1st set, with 125 losses by sweeps and 34 in three sets.
Martins Plavins / Edgars Tocs (LAT)	Have a career 66-52 (55.9%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 33-31 (51.6%) record in 2019-21. They are 49-6 (89.1%) when winning the 1st set, with 43 wins by sweeps and 6 in three sets. They are 13-46 (22.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 32 losses by sweeps and 14 in three sets.
Adrian Carambula / Enrico Rossi (ITA)	Have a career 39-27 (59.1%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 39-27 (59.1%) record in 2019-21. They are 33-5 (86.8%) when winning the 1st set, with 26 wins by sweeps and 7 in three sets. They are 6-21 (22.2%) when losing the 1st set, with 16 losses by sweeps and 5 in three sets.
Phil Dalhausser / Nick Lucena (USA)	Have a career 195-72 (73.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 41-32 (56.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 163-7 (95.9%) when winning the 1st set, with 141 wins by sweeps and 22 in three sets. They are 31-62 (33.3%) when losing the 1st set, with 46 losses by sweeps and 16 in three sets.
Esteban Grimalt / Marco Grimalt (CHI)	Have a career 155-152 (50.5%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 43-38 (53.1%) record in 2019-21. They are 114-24 (82.6%) when winning the 1st set, with 94 wins by sweeps and 20 in three sets. They are 36-128 (22.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 100 losses by sweeps and 28 in three sets.

Daniele Lupo / Paolo Nicolai (ITA)	Have a career 304-152 (66.7%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 45-23 (66.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 241-34 (87.6%) when winning the 1st set, with 187 wins by sweeps and 54 in three sets. They are 59-117 (33.5%) when losing the 1st set, with 83 losses by sweeps and 34 in three sets.
Piotr Kantor / Bartosz Losiak (POL)	Have a career 244-157 (60.8%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 44-26 (62.9%) record in 2019-21. They are 203-27 (88.3%) when winning the 1st set, with 166 wins by sweeps and 37 in three sets. They are 38-124 (23.5%) when losing the 1st set, with 94 losses by sweeps and 30 in three sets.
Mohamed Abicha / Zouheir Elgraoui (MAR)	Have a career 2-8 (20.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 0-3 (0.0%) record in 2019-21. They are 2-1 (66.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 2 wins by sweeps and 0 in three sets. They are 0-7 (0.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 7 losses by sweeps and 0 in three sets.
Julian Azaad / Nicolas Capogrosso (ARG)	Have a career 28-40 (41.2%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 12-19 (38.7%) record in 2019-21. They are 24-5 (82.8%) when winning the 1st set, with 18 wins by sweeps and 6 in three sets. They are 4-34 (10.5%) when losing the 1st set, with 26 losses by sweeps and 8 in three sets.
Mirco Gerson / Adrian Heidrich (SUI)	Have a career 68-54 (55.7%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 39-36 (52.0%) record in 2019-21. They are 54-11 (83.1%) when winning the 1st set, with 46 wins by sweeps and 8 in three sets. They are 14-43 (24.6%) when losing the 1st set, with 29 losses by sweeps and 14 in three sets.
Josue Gaxiola / Jose Rubio (MEX)	Have a career 12-15 (44.4%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 12-12 (50.0%) record in 2019-21. They are 12-4 (75.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 9 wins by sweeps and 3 in three sets. They are 0-10 (0.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 8 losses by sweeps and 2 in three sets.
Christopher McHugh / Damien Schumann (AUS)	Have a career 37-23 (61.7%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 5-1 (83.3%) record in 2019-21. They are 30-5 (85.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 24 wins by sweeps and 6 in three sets. They are 7-18 (28.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 15 losses by sweeps and 3 in three sets.
