Melissa Humana-Paredes / Sarah Pavan (CAN)	Have a career 144-52 (73.5%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 76-28 (73.1%) record in 2019-21. They are 125-8 (94.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 100 wins by sweeps and 25 in three sets. They are 19-44 (30.2%) when losing the 1st set, with 33 losses by sweeps and 11 in three sets.
Alix Klineman / April Ross (USA)	Have a career 95-31 (75.4%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 71-22 (76.3%) record in 2019-21. They are 81-7 (92.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 68 wins by sweeps and 13 in three sets. They are 14-23 (37.8%) when losing the 1st set, with 18 losses by sweeps and 5 in three sets.
Agatha Bednarczuk / Eduarda "Duda" Lisboa (BRA)	Have a career 161-55 (74.5%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 79-26 (75.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 135-14 (90.6%) when winning the 1st set, with 114 wins by sweeps and 21 in three sets. They are 23-41 (35.9%) when losing the 1st set, with 30 losses by sweeps and 11 in three sets.
Rebecca Cavalcanti / Ana Patricia Silva (BRA)	Have a career 91-29 (75.8%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 84-23 (78.5%) record in 2019-21. They are 81-9 (90.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 66 wins by sweeps and 15 in three sets. They are 9-19 (32.1%) when losing the 1st set, with 15 losses by sweeps and 4 in three sets.
Mariafe Artacho / Taliqua Clancy (AUS)	Have a career 92-30 (75.4%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 49-16 (75.4%) record in 2019-21. They are 73-7 (91.3%) when winning the 1st set, with 60 wins by sweeps and 13 in three sets. They are 18-23 (43.9%) when losing the 1st set, with 14 losses by sweeps and 9 in three sets.
Miki Ishii / Megumi Murakami (JPN)	Have a career 64-65 (49.6%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 30-37 (44.8%) record in 2019-21. They are 50-9 (84.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 40 wins by sweeps and 10 in three sets. They are 12-56 (17.6%) when losing the 1st set, with 46 losses by sweeps and 10 in three sets.
Nina Betschart / Tanja Huberli (SUI)	Have a career 123-88 (58.3%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 53-29 (64.6%) record in 2019-21. They are 96-11 (89.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 81 wins by sweeps and 15 in three sets. They are 23-77 (23.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 55 losses by sweeps and 22 in three sets.
Svetlana Kholomina / Nadezda Makroguzova (ROC)	Have a career 72-45 (61.5%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 44-26 (62.9%) record in 2019-21. They are 63-7 (90.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 54 wins by sweeps and 9 in three sets. They are 8-37 (17.8%) when losing the 1st set, with 25 losses by sweeps and 12 in three sets.

Kelly Claes / Sarah Sponcil (USA)	Have a career 77-30 (72.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 77-30 (72.0%) record in 2019-21. They are 67-8 (89.3%) when winning the 1st set, with 58 wins by sweeps and 9 in three sets. They are 10-22 (31.3%) when losing the 1st set, with 16 losses by sweeps and 6 in three sets.
Heather Bansley / Brandie Wilkerson (CAN)	Have a career 107-60 (64.1%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 53-28 (65.4%) record in 2019-21. They are 89-14 (86.4%) when winning the 1st set, with 67 wins by sweeps and 22 in three sets. They are 17-46 (27.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 33 losses by sweeps and 13 in three sets.
Sanne Keizer / Madelein Meppelink (NED)	Have a career 74-53 (58.3%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 47-30 (61.0%) record in 2019-21. They are 62-10 (86.1%) when winning the 1st set, with 58 wins by sweeps and 4 in three sets. They are 11-42 (20.8%) when losing the 1st set, with 35 losses by sweeps and 7 in three sets.
Joana Heidrich / Anouk Verge-Depre (SUI)	Have a career 78-55 (58.6%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 42-29 (59.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 63-15 (80.8%) when winning the 1st set, with 49 wins by sweeps and 14 in three sets. They are 14-39 (26.4%) when losing the 1st set, with 32 losses by sweeps and 7 in three sets.
Karla Borger / Julia Sude (GER)	Have a career 53-41 (56.4%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 50-39 (56.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 42-15 (73.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 35 wins by sweeps and 7 in three sets. They are 11-26 (29.7%) when losing the 1st set, with 19 losses by sweeps and 7 in three sets.
Elsa Baquerizo / Liliana Fernandez (ESP)	Have a career 296-232 (56.1%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 33-29 (53.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 236-43 (84.6%) when winning the 1st set, with 189 wins by sweeps and 47 in three sets. They are 54-189 (22.2%) when losing the 1st set, with 138 losses by sweeps and 51 in three sets.
Fan Wang / Xinyi Xia (CHN)	Have a career 66-55 (54.5%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 32-33 (49.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 52-10 (83.9%) when winning the 1st set, with 41 wins by sweeps and 11 in three sets. They are 12-44 (21.4%) when losing the 1st set, with 33 losses by sweeps and 11 in three sets.
Tina Graudina / Anastasija Kravcenoka (LAT)	Have a career 53-46 (53.5%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 34-30 (53.1%) record in 2019-21. They are 48-8 (85.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 37 wins by sweeps and 11 in three sets. They are 4-38 (9.5%) when losing the 1st set, with 27 losses by sweeps and 11 in three sets.
Marta Menegatti / Viktoria Orsi Toth (ITA)	Have a career 167-112 (59.9%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 33-31 (51.6%) record in 2019-21. They are 141-29 (82.9%) when winning the 1st set, with 115 wins by sweeps and 26 in three sets. They are 24-82 (22.6%) when losing the 1st set, with 63 losses by sweeps and 19 in three sets.

Margareta Kozuch / Laura Ludwig (GER)	Have a career 41-31 (56.9%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 39-28 (58.2%) record in 2019-21. They are 33-9 (78.6%) when winning the 1st set, with 28 wins by sweeps and 5 in three sets. They are 8-22 (26.7%) when losing the 1st set, with 18 losses by sweeps and 4 in three sets.
Barbora Hermannova / Marketa Slukova (CZE)	Have a career 140-80 (63.6%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 35-25 (58.3%) record in 2019-21. They are 117-16 (88.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 94 wins by sweeps and 23 in three sets. They are 22-60 (26.8%) when losing the 1st set, with 46 losses by sweeps and 14 in three sets.
Lidiannis Echeverria / Leila Martinez (CUB)	Have a career 4-4 (50.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 0-0 (N/A%) record in 2019-21. They are 4-0 (100.0%) when winning the 1st set, with 4 wins by sweeps and 0 in three sets. They are 0-4 (0.0%) when losing the 1st set, with 3 losses by sweeps and 1 in three sets.
Brackcides Khadambi / Gaudencia Makokha (KEN)	Have never played before on the FIVB World Tour.
Ana Gallay / Fernanda Pereyra (ARG)	Have a career 13-28 (31.7%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 9-18 (33.3%) record in 2019-21. They are 8-5 (61.5%) when winning the 1st set, with 3 wins by sweeps and 5 in three sets. They are 4-22 (15.4%) when losing the 1st set, with 15 losses by sweeps and 7 in three sets.
Xinxin Wang / Chen Xue (CHN)	Have a career 27-33 (45.0%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 22-25 (46.8%) record in 2019-21. They are 24-9 (72.7%) when winning the 1st set, with 18 wins by sweeps and 6 in three sets. They are 3-24 (11.1%) when losing the 1st set, with 18 losses by sweeps and 6 in three sets.
Raisa Schoon / Katja Stam (NED)	Have a career 14-10 (58.3%) match record in FIVB World Tour Events and a 14-10 (58.3%) record in 2019-21. They are 13-3 (81.3%) when winning the 1st set, with 10 wins by sweeps and 3 in three sets. They are 1-7 (12.5%) when losing the 1st set, with 2 losses by sweeps and 5 in three sets.
