- Playing her 53<sup>rd</sup> career AVP tournament and her 1<sup>st</sup> Austin event.
- Owns eight career AVP titles and four runner-up finishes.
- Has won at least one AVP title in each of the last four years and in five of the last six seasons.
- Has reached AVP semifinals 24 times in her career, including Huntington Beach this year.
- Teamed with Brittany Hochevar to win an AVP Tour best three events in 2017, including Huntington Beach.

### Betsi Flint – age 26 – 5’10” – hometown Phoenix, Ariz. – currently Los Angeles, Calif. – Loyola Marymount

- Playing in her 27<sup>th</sup> career AVP tournament.
- Making her 2<sup>nd</sup> Austin tournament appearance (7<sup>th</sup> with Kelley Larsen in 2017).
- Has won four times on the AVP, twice with current partner Emily Day (Seattle and San Francisco in 2018) and twice with Kelley Larsen (Cincinnati, 2015 and San Francisco, 2017).
- Was named the AVP Newcomer of the Year in 2015.
- Married Chase Flint in 2014, a former basketball player at Loyola Marymount.
- Played in every single match during her four-years at Loyola Marymount and left the school as the all-time leader in both digs and aces.

- Urango was named the AVP Most Improved Player in 2016, while Ledoux claimed the same honor in 2017.

### Caitlin Ledoux – age 28 – 6’2” – hometown Phelan, Calif. – currently Phelan, Calif. – Long Beach State

- Will be playing her 41st career AVP event.
- Will be playing in Austin for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time (9<sup>th</sup> in 2017 with Heather McGuire and 7<sup>th</sup> in 2018 with Kendra Van Zwieten) with the 3<sup>rd</sup> different partner.
- Has played with 11 different partners on the AVP, including five in seven events last year.
- Posted two runner-up finishes last year – 2<sup>nd</sup> in Seattle with April Ross and 2<sup>nd</sup> in San Francisco with current teammate Geena Urango (lost to Emily Day / Betsi Flint in both championship matches).
- Played tournaments with Ali McColloch (3), Ledoux (2) and Allie Wheeler (2) last year, having the most success with current partner Ledoux.

### Geena Urango – age 29 – 5’11” – hometown Los Alamitos, Calif. – currently Los Alamitos, Calif. - USC

- Will be playing her 41st career AVP event.
- Is playing in Austin for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time. Teamed with Angela Bensed to finish 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2017 (lost to Pavlik/Ross in semifinals) and was 13<sup>th</sup> in 2018, losing only two matches, both in three sets with partner Ali McColloch.
- Has five runner-up finishes on the AVP, reaching the finals of a tournament at least once in each of the last four seasons (twice in 2016).
- Has reached the semifinals in 11 events in the last four years.
- Will be playing in Huntington Beach for the 5<sup>th</sup> time with a career-best finish of second with Angela Bensed in 2016 (fell in championship to April Ross / Kerri Walsh Jennings).

- Played indoor at Stanford and one year of beach at Pepperdine.

### Kelly Reeves – age 27 – 6'0" – hometown San Diego, Calif. – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. - UCLA

- Will be playing her 23<sup>rd</sup> AVP event.
- Playing in Austin for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time (9<sup>th</sup> last year with Reeves and 5<sup>th</sup> in 2017 with Jennifer Fopma, which included a win over top-seed Flint/Larsen before being eliminated).
- Has reached three semifinals in her career (two in 2017 and one last year).

### Jace Pardon – age 25 – 5’10” – hometown Manhattan Beach, Calif. – currently Manhattan Beach, Calif. – Florida St

- Playing in her 21<sup>st</sup> career AVP tournament and 3<sup>rd</sup> Austin event.
- Her best AVP finish last year came at Austin (9<sup>th</sup> with Brittany Tiegs). They won their first match of last year’s tournament against current partner Karissa Cook (and Katie Spielers).
- Other Austin finish was 13<sup>th</sup> with Alix Klineman in 2017.

Has never reached a semifinal as her best finish has been 5<sup>th</sup> at Huntington Beach this year with Cook and in the 2016 Chicago event with Brittany Tiegs.

## **WOMEN – #5 Terese Cannon / Irene Pollock – Austin – May 17-19, 2019**

- Team is playing together for the first time.
- Both players are making their 2019 AVP debut.
- The team's No. 5 seed is the best for Cannon (previous best 13<sup>th</sup> at Hermosa Beach in 2017) and is the 2<sup>nd</sup> best for Pollock, who was 4<sup>th</sup> seed with Amanda Dowdy last year in Austin

### **Terese Cannon – age 23 – 6'3" – hometown Pittsford, N.Y. – currently Pittsford, N.Y. – Georgetown / USC**

- Playing her 14th career AVP tournament and her 1<sup>st</sup> Austin event.
- Played all seven AVP events last year, but had four different partners on the year (Corinne Quiggle, Jace Pardon, Nicolette Martin, Sarah Sponcil).
- Best career AVP finish was 3<sup>rd</sup> at Chicago with Sarah Sponcil where they lost to Sara Hughes/Summer Ross in the semifinals.
- Only three times in 13 career AVP events has she finished better than 15<sup>th</sup> (7<sup>th</sup> in San Francisco in 2017, 3<sup>rd</sup> in Chicago in 2018 and 7<sup>th</sup> in Hawaii in 2018).
- She is starting in the main bracket for just the 4<sup>th</sup> time in 13 open AVP events (does not include Hawaii last year).
- Entering Austin she has played 25 qualifying AVP matches and 25 main draw matches in her career.

### **Irene Pollock – age 30 – 6'1" – hometown Fort Worth, Texas – currently Hermosa Beach, Calif. – TCU**

- Playing in her 25<sup>th</sup> career AVP tournament and her 3<sup>rd</sup> Austin event (3<sup>rd</sup> in 2017 and 13<sup>th</sup> in 2018, both with Amanda Dowdy).
- Her 3<sup>rd</sup> at Austin in 2017 was her career-best AVP finish (matched in 2018 in Seattle).
- Just missed the semifinals in three events during 2015 and 2016 before breaking through in 2017 at Austin in 2017, when she and Dowdy reached the final four before falling to Kim DiCello/Emily Stockman in three sets.
- Made her AVP debut in 2014 and recorded a 7<sup>th</sup>-place finish with Caitlin Ledoux in her 2<sup>nd</sup> event at Salt Lake City.

- This is 2<sup>nd</sup> Austin tournament as she and Emily Stockman finished 2<sup>nd</sup> here in 2017. Duo won 1<sup>st</sup> four matches before losing in finals to Pavlik/A. Ross in a three-set championship match.
- Will be playing in her 46th career AVP event.
- Has one career victory on the AVP Tour, winning the 2016 New Orleans event with Kendra Van Zwieten as part of her three career championship appearances (runner-up 2017 Austin with Emily Stockman and 2015 Chicago with Van Zwieten).
- Played one FIVB event in October, placing 9<sup>th</sup> with Irene Pollock at Cetumal, Mexico.

### Katie Spieler – age 24 – 5'5" – hometown Santa Barbara, Calif. – currently Santa Barbara, Calif. - Hawaii

- Playing her 20<sup>th</sup> AVP Tour event with a best finish of 3<sup>rd</sup> in last year's Austin event with Karissa Cook.
- This will be her 3<sup>rd</sup> Austin event.
- Reached last year's Austin semifinal with Karissa Cook after losing in 1<sup>st</sup> round (won four straight contenders bracket matches before falling to Fendrick/Sponcil in semifinal).
- Also played in Austin in 2017, but she and Amanda Wiggins lost both matches to finish 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Six of her 14 losses last year went three sets, including three of the last four defeats in the final two tournaments combined (partner was Karissa Cook).

- Finished second at the FIVB Phnom Penh Two Star in February and 5<sup>th</sup> at the Kuala Lumpur Three Star in early May.
- Both players are making their 2019 AVP debut after not playing in Huntington Beach.

### **Amanda Dowdy – age 29 – 6’2” – hometown Austin, Texas – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Texas Tech**

- Playing in her hometown for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time. She placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2017 (matched career best finish) and 13<sup>th</sup> in 2018 (both with Irene Pollock).
- Her 2017 Austin tournament, included a victory over top-seed Flint/Larsen in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round. She was eliminated in the semifinals by Kim DiCello/Emily Stockman in 3 sets.
- Playing her 31<sup>st</sup> career AVP event.
- Best career finishes are 3<sup>rd</sup> on four occasions, reaching the semifinals of a tournament once in each of the previous four seasons (Chicago 2015, New Orleans 2016, Austin 2017, Seattle 2018).
- Placed 5<sup>th</sup> 5 times in her career.

### **Corinne Quiggle – age 22 – 5’10” – hometown Ponte Vedra Beach, Fla.– currently Manhattan Beach, Calif. – Pepperdine**

- Playing in her 17<sup>th</sup> career AVP tournament.
- Played in the Austin event last year, but did not make it out of the qualifier with Allie Wheeler (won two matches before falling to Janelle Allen/Kerri Schuh).
- Best career AVP finish was 5<sup>th</sup> at Manhattan Beach with Kimberly Smith last year.
- Her AVP debut in 2015 resulted in a 13<sup>th</sup> place finish at Manhattan Beach with Elise Zappia

- Team is playing together for the 1<sup>st</sup> time.
- Knudsen is playing for the first time in 2019, while Wheeler played at Huntington Beach with Kimberly Smith.

### Delaney Knudsen – age 23 – 5'10" – hometown Valencia, Calif. – currently Valencia, Calif. – Pepperdine

- Playing her 23<sup>rd</sup> career AVP tournament and her 1<sup>st</sup> Austin event.
- Has not advanced out of qualifying in two previous Austin events.
- Career-best AVP finishes were 9<sup>th</sup> at San Francisco in 2017 with Branagan Fuller and at Seattle in 2018 with Jessica Sykora.
- Played in all 7 AVP events last year, and is making her 2019 debut in Austin.
- Is making her 2<sup>nd</sup> ever start in a main draw (was the 20<sup>th</sup> seed at Manhattan Beach in 2015).

### Allie Wheeler – age 23 – 5'11" – hometown Saratoga, Calif. – currently Saratoga, Calif. - USC

- Playing her 19<sup>th</sup> AVP event, 2<sup>nd</sup> this year and 3<sup>rd</sup> Austin tournament.
- Austin finishes include 9<sup>th</sup> with Nicolette Martin in 2017 and 17<sup>th</sup> with Corinne Quiggle in 2018.
- In first tournament of the year at Huntington Beach, she teamed with Kimberly Smith, but the duo went 0-2 with both losses coming in three sets.
- Her three 5<sup>th</sup>-place finishes last year (with three different partners) are her best AVP finishes.
- Had five different partners in seven events in 2018 (Corinne Quiggle (1), Bre Moreland (1), Nicolette Martin (2), Nicole Branagh (1), Geena Urango (2)).
- Playing in Huntington Beach event for 1<sup>st</sup> time.

- Married to pro beach volleyball player Billy Allen.
- Playing in her 90th career AVP event.
- Finished 13<sup>th</sup> in Austin in 2017 with Briana Hinga and 5<sup>th</sup> last year with current partner Kerri Schuh.
- Has three career 5<sup>th</sup>-place finishes with one in each of the previous three seasons.
- Played one tournament with Angela Bendsend last year, placing 9<sup>th</sup> at New York.
- Played just one event on the AVP Tour in the four years between 2010 and 2015. (played 59 from 2006-10 and 28 from 2015-18).

**Kerri Schuh** – age 30 – 6'0" – hometown Appleton, Wis. – currently Hermosa Beach, Calif. – Wisconsin-Milwaukee

- Playing her 29<sup>th</sup> career AVP event.
- Playing 3<sup>rd</sup> Austin event. Did not advance out of qualifier in 2017 with Bre Moreland and was 5<sup>th</sup> last year with Janelle Allen.
