- Chicago marks their 4th AVP event this year as they won 2 of the previous 3 events they played in this season.
- Duo had won five consecutive AVP events they entered (includes Waikiki last year) until finishing 2nd 2 weeks ago at Manhattan Beach (lost to Humana-Paredes / Pavan in 3 sets) and has 6 AVP championships in 10 tournaments together.
- They have finished top 3 in all 10 of their previous AVP events (1st 6 times, 2nd twice and 3rd 2 times).
- Team owns a 45-4 career match record and had won 30 consecutive matches until the Manhattan Beach final.
- They are 15-1 in matches this year.

April Ross – age 36 – 6’1” – hometown Newport Beach, Calif. – currently Costa Mesa, Calif. – USC

- Playing her 102nd career AVP event and has 35 titles, 16 runner-up finishes and a total of 72 semifinal appearances.
- Has reached Chicago semifinals in 4 of her last 5 appearances (3rd in 2008, 2nd in 2009, 3rd in 2017 and 1st last year).
- Has recorded at least 2 AVP titles in each of the last 8 years, including this season.
- Despite having played just 3 AVP events, her 38 aces are 5th on tour.

Alex Klineman – age 29 – 6’5” – hometown Manhattan Beach, Calif. – currently Manhattan Beach, Calif. - Stanford

- Playing in her 23rd career AVP event and 3rd Chicago tournament.
- Was 9th in Chicago with Lane Carico in 2017 and won this event last year with April Ross.
- Has 6 career AVP victories (all with April Ross). She played her first 12 AVP events with 7 different partners and had a best finish of 2nd with Lane Carico at San Francisco in 2017 (lost to Flint /Larsen in final).
- Her .479 hitting percentage is 4th on the AVP this year.
- Klineman’s 2018 AVP stat rankings included 3rd in hitting percentage (.491), 4th in aces (.96 per set) and 5th in blocks (1.09 per set).

- Owns 9 career AVP titles and 5 runner-up finishes.
- Has won at least one AVP title in each of the last 5 years and in 6 of the last 7 seasons.
- Has reached AVP semifinals 26 times in her career, including 3 times in 6 events this year.

Betsi Flint – age 26 – 5'10" – hometown Phoenix, Ariz. – currently Los Angeles, Calif. – Loyola Marymount

- Playing in her 32nd career AVP tournament and 5th Chicago event. Best finish here was 2nd with Kelley Larsen in 2016 (lost to Fendrick / Sweat in 3-set final – 21-14, 10-21, 17-19).
- Has won 5 times on the AVP, 3 times with current partner Emily Day and twice with Kelley Larsen (Cincinnati, 2015 and San Francisco, 2017).
