

**Manhattan Beach – Stadium Court Notes – Friday, August 19, 2022 – Match 4**  
**10:15 am – #2 Tri Bourne / Trevor Crabb vs. #31 Wyatt Harrison / Charlie Siragusa**

**Head to Head**

- This is the first meeting between the teams and the first meeting ever between the four individuals

**Bourne / Trevor Crabb** are playing together for the 17th time on the AVP Tour and 45th time overall... they have 3 AVP wins (Long Beach 2020 event #3, Manhattan Beach 2021, Fort Lauderdale 2022) and 1 FIVB win (Qinzhou 2018)

- Bourne was 8-0 vs Trevor Crabb on the AVP Tour, while Trevor Crabb was 1-0 vs Bourne on the FIVB Tour
- In their first 2 events this year they were seeded first, the first time ever the pair has been seeded #1 on the AVP Tour
- In 5 seasons as partners on the AVP, they are 48-24 (67%) in matches, 42-5 (89%) when winning the first set, 6-19 (24%) when losing the first set, and 16-9 (64%) in three-set matches
- Last event in Atlanta the duo lost consecutive matches, the first time ever in their AVP partnership (losing 2 straight within the same tournament)
- Last year the duo won in Manhattan Beach

**Tri Bourne – age 33 – 6'5" – hometown Honolulu, Hawai'i – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Southern Cal**

- This is Bourne's 38th AVP event... he has played with just 3 partners in his career (with just one event with Raffae Paulis, the remainder with John Hyden and Crabb)
- He has won 6 times, placed 2nd 7 times, and placed 3rd 13 times... he has advanced to the semifinals in 26 of his 37 completed AVP events (70% of the tournaments entered)
- Bourne has advanced to the semifinals in 26 of his last 33 AVP tournaments
- Bourne has played in the semifinals in Manhattan Beach 4 times, including winning last year

**Trevor Crabb – age 32 – 6'4" – hometown Honolulu, Hawai'i. – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Puget Sound / Long Beach State**

- Trevor Crabb is playing in his 54th AVP Tournament, with 4 wins, 8 second-place finishes, and 15 third-place finishes... his first 3 wins came in California before winning in Florida
- Crabb and Casey Patterson are the only players to have reached the semifinals in each of the past 9 years (2014-2022)
- Crabb made his AVP debut in the 2013 Manhattan Beach Open with his brother Taylor Crabb (finished 25th)
- Crabb has won each of the last 2 Manhattan Beach Opens and advanced to the semifinals 3 other times here... he is striving to become the 11th different men's player to win 3 consecutive MBO titles

**Harrison / Siragusa** are playing together for the 1st time ever

- The duo is one of 6 men's teams in the main draw who are playing together for the first time ever
- They earned a berth to the main draw in Manhattan Beach via a USAV wildcard for collegiate beach teams
- The two players were teammates at UC-San Diego in each of the last 3 seasons

**Wyatt Harrison – age 23 – 6'6" – hometown Santa Cruz, Calif. – currently Santa Cruz, Calif. – UC-San Diego**

- This is Harrison's 10th AVP event with his 6th different partner
- His career best is a 17th in Hermosa Beach 2019, which is the only previous time he had played in an AVP main draw

**Charlie Siragusa – 6'9" – hometown Rochester, N.Y. – currently Webster, N.Y. – Brigham Young / UC-San Diego**

- This is Siragusa's 4th AVP event with his 4th different partner, and it is his first AVP main draw
