

Huntington Beach Miscellaneous Notes from Saturday

MEN

- The 6 teams left on Sunday include seeds 1-5 and 7
- So far 10 of the 24 matches went three sets, and teams winning the first set are 20-4
- Troy Field has been eliminated but leads the field in hitting percentage (.633)
- Phil Dalhausser has the most aces (9) while Taylor Sander has the highest average (.86 aces / set)
- The leading blockers (totals) are all "B's" as Budinger (17), Brunner (15) and Bourne (14) have the most... Brian Miller leads in average (2.17) in a tight race over Brunner (2.14) and Budinger (2.13)
- Avery Drost has 64 digs (next most is 47)... Seain Cook leads in average (5.50 digs / set)

Women

- The 6 teams left on Sunday include seeds 1-5 and 16 (the 6th seed in the qualifier)
 - Madelyne Anderson and Molly Turner are playing together for the first time on the AVP... in Huntington Beach they have played 7 matches, and they are 6-0 in "win or go home" matches
 - Anderson and Turner are trying to become the 3rd team in AVP history to advance to the semifinals as the 16th seed in a 16-team main draw (Kelly Cheng / Sara Hughes in New York 2015 and Skylar Caputo / Sarah Pavan in Seattle 2017)
- So far 8 of the 24 matches went three sets, and teams winning the first set are 20-4
- The top 4 players in hitting percentage are all beach Olympians (Kelly Cheng .603, Brandie Wilkerson .563, Sarah Sponcil .524, Larissa Maestrini .483)
- Zana Munoz leads in total aces (7) while Kelly Cheng leads in average (.83 aces / set)
- Terese Cannon leads all players with 17 blocks while Kelly Cheng leads in average (2.00 blocks / set)
- Sarah Sponcil leads the field in total digs (70) while Kristen Nuss leads in average (9.00 / set)
