

Huntington Beach Miscellaneous Notes from Sunday

MEN

- There were a total of 7 upsets
- 13 of the 29 matches went three sets, and teams winning the first set were 24-5
- Troy Field lead the field in hitting percentage (.633)
- Taylor Sander had both the most aces (10) as well as the highest average (.83 aces / set)
- The leading blockers (totals) were all "B's" as Andy Benesh (32), Tri Bourne (25) and Chase Budinger (19) had the most... Brian Miller led in average (2.17) in a tight race over Benesh (2.13)
 - In the first 2 events, the most blocks in a match was 7, but that was eclipsed four times in Huntington (Tri Bourne 9 in the second round, Theo Brunner 9 in the second round, Andy Benesh 9 in the semifinals, Tri Bourne 8 in the semifinals)
- Avery Drost had 69 digs, just ahead of Miles Partain (66)... Seain Cook led in average (5.50 digs / set)
- Tri Bourne / Chaim Schalk and Phil Dalhausser / Avery Drost each played 4 three-set matches (out of 5 matches for each team)

Women

- There were a total of 7 upsets
- 12 of the 29 matches went three sets, and teams winning the first set were 23-6
- Just one player had a hitting percentage over .500 (Brandie Wilkerson .615)
- Betsi Flint led in total aces with 10 (next most was 7) while Toni Rodriguez led in average (.80 aces / set)
- Terese Cannon led all players with 22 blocks while Sarah Pavan led in average (1.75 blocks / set)
- Betsi Flint and Sarah Sponcil shared the lead in total digs (99) while Geena Urango led in average (8.67 / set)
 - Zana Muno had 31 digs in her contender's second round match, the most in any match on Tour this season
- Terese Cannon / Sarah Sponcil played 6 matches and 5 of them went to a third set
