- Team is the defending Manhattan Beach champion (defeated Claes / Hochevar in 3-set finals).
- Manhattan marks just their 3rd AVP event this year as they won each of the previous two events they played in this season.
- Duo has won five consecutive AVP events they have entered (includes Waikiki last year) and has 6 AVP championships in 9 tournaments.
- They have finished top 3 in all 9 of their previous AVP events (1st 6 times, 2nd once and 3rd 2 times).
- Team owns a 40-3 career match record and has won 25 consecutive AVP matches dating back to last year as the last team to beat them was Hughes / S. Ross in the Hermosa Beach finals in 2018. They have only lost 7 sets during the streak.
- They are a perfect 10-0 in matches this year.

April Ross – age 36 – 6’1” – hometown Newport Beach, Calif. – currently Costa Mesa, Calif. – USC

- Playing her 101st career AVP event and has 35 titles, 15 runner-up finishes and a total of 71 semifinal appearances.
- Has 3 Manhattan Beach titles (2014 with Kerri Walsh Jennings, 2015 with Jennifer Fopma and last year with Klineman).
- Has recorded at least 2 AVP titles in each of the last 8 years, including this season.

Alex Klineman – age 29 – 6’5” – hometown Manhattan Beach, Calif. – currently Manhattan Beach, Calif. - Stanford

- Playing in her 22nd career AVP event and 6th Manhattan Beach tournament.
- First played Manhattan in 2005 with Stephanie Barry (33rd) and 2006 with Geena Urango (57th). Returned in 2016 with Kristin Hildebrand (57th), 2017 with Lane Carico (7th) and last year with Ross (1st).
- Leads the tour with a .531 hitting percentage (only player above .500).
- Klineman’s 2018 AVP stat rankings included 3rd in hitting percentage (.491), 4th in aces (.96 per set) and 5th in blocks (1.09 per set).

- Tied for tour lead with 52 blocks (Kelley Larsen) and is 2nd in hitting percentage at .493 (Alix Klineman).

- Has won 5 times on the AVP, 3 times with current partner Emily Day and twice with Kelley Larsen (Cincinnati, 2015 and San Francisco, 2017).
- Has reached 9 title matches in 30 events.
- Flint’s 60 aces lead the tour by 24 (partner Emily Day is 2nd with 36). Flint also leads in digs (298).
