Emily Stockman

- Led Winthrop to NCAA Tournament as a freshman
- Two time All American and 2008 Conference Player of the Year at Wichita State... all-time leader in kills per set and member of Wichita State Hall of Fame
- Played professionally in France, Finland, Sweden and Switzerland
- Made her AVP debut after her junior season, in Manhattan Beach 2009... that was the only time in her pro beach career that she did not play in the main draw of an AVP event
- Her first two AVP main draw wins came against teams seeded 3rd and 4th
- She won in Seattle 2019 with Kelley Kolinske
- On the AVP Tour she advanced to 10 semifinals with 6 different partners
- Twice she played in the semifinals in Manhattan Beach, in 2018 and again last month
- During her career she played an AVP event in 13 different states, advancing to the semifinals in 6 of them
- In 2022 Stockman played in 15 international events, more than any other women's player on the World Beach Pro Tour
- Entering Chicago she has played 53 AVP tournaments with a 117-100 (.539) match record
