

Chicago – Stadium Court Notes – Saturday, September 3, 2022 – Match 3
10:15 am – #12 Billy Allen / Jeremy Casebeer vs #13 John Hyden / Logan Webber

Head to Head

- These two teams played in Fort Lauderdale, with Hyden / Webber winning 23-21, 21-16
- Casebeer won the first meeting against Webber (in Chicago last year) but Webber has since won the last 2 meetings
- Webber is 2-0 against Allen, with both meetings happening in July 2022
- All time Hyden has a 27-5 record against Allen, including winning the first 21 times... Allen has won 3 of the last 4 meetings however... the two met in the 2018 Hermosa Beach finals, with Hyden winning
- Hyden owns a slim 6-5 lead in matches against Casebeer all time... there was one forfeit (Casebeer won by forfeit), and of the 10 matches played 6 have gone to a third set

Allen / Casebeer are playing together for the 8th time ever

- They have a best together of 5th place (done 3 times)
- The duo has had 3 5ths, 3 9ths and 1 13th place finish
- On the AVP Tour they have a 13-15 match record... they are 9-5 when winning the first set and 4-10 when losing the first set... they are 6-8 in three-set matches
- The duo enters this match having lost 3 straight matches and 8 of their last 12

Billy Allen – age 40 – 6'2" – hometown Fallbrook, Calif. – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Cal State Northridge

- This is Allen's 122nd AVP event with his 16th different partner
- He has 2 wins (in Seattle 2016 with Theo Brunner and in Seattle 2017 with Stafford Slick), 3 2nds and 11 3rds
- All 5 of Allen's AVP championship match appearances came between 2016 and 2018
- This is Allen's 12time playing in Chicago (on all tours)... he has advanced to the semifinals twice (3rd in 2017 with Stafford Slick and 3rd last year with Andy Benesh)

Jeremy Casebeer – age 33 - 6'5" – hometown Santa Barbara, Calif. – currently Santa Barbara, Calif. – UCLA

- This is Casebeer's 66th AVP event with his 12th different partner
- He has 1 win (Seattle in 2019 with Chaim Schalk), 2 2nds and 10 3rds
- Casebeer had perhaps his best season in 2019 (1 win, 1 2nd, 2 3rds), but hasn't reached the semifinals since then (has completed 13 AVP tournaments since then)
- Casebeer is playing in Chicago for the 8th time... he made it to the semifinals in 3 straight Chicago events with 3 different partners (3rd in 2017 with John Mayer, 3rd in 2018 with Reid Priddy and 3rd in 2019 with Chaim Schalk)

Hyden / Webber are playing together for the 7th time on the AVP Tour

- The duo placed 5th in Austin, 9th in New Orleans and Hermosa Beach and 5th in Fort Lauderdale, 9th in Atlanta and 13th in Fort Lauderdale
- As partners they are 11-13 in matches... they are 10-5 when winning the first set, and 1-8 when losing the first set... they are 3-6 in three-set matches
- 9 of their 13 match losses have come against teams seeded 5th or better
- In the season opener in Austin, the duo broke the AVP record for having the biggest age discrepancy between partners in a main draw (23 years, 0 months and 22 days difference in age)

John Hyden – age 49 – 6'5" – hometown San Diego, Calif. – currently Sherman Oaks, Calif. – San Diego State

- This is Hyden's 163rd AVP event with 19 different partners... he has 13 AVP titles, and his last one came in Hermosa Beach 2018... in that tournament he set the record for being the oldest player to ever win an AVP event (was 45 years, 9 months, 22 days old)

- He owns the AVP record for being the oldest player to play in a main draw
- Hyden's last semifinal came in the 2019 finale, and since then he has lost in the 5th-place match 5 times
- Across all tours this is Hyden's 16th time playing in Chicago, tying Ed Ratledge for the most in history... his first time was in August 2002, when Miles Partain (the youngest player here) was just 8 months old
- Hyden's first ever AVP championship match was right here in Chicago in 2004 with Mike Lambert (lost to Dain Blanton / Jeff Nygaard)
- He has won 3 times in Chicago (2 times on the AVP), and played in the finals 6 times... his wins came in 2009 and 2011 with Sean Scott and in 2017 with Ryan Doherty

Logan Webber – age 26 – 6'7" – hometown Grand Rapids, Mich. – currently Grand Rapids, Mich. – Cincinnati Christian

- Webber is playing in his 26th AVP Tournament with 9 different partners
- Webber's first semifinal came in Denver as he and Seain Cook placed third on the Tour Series event
- His career best outside of the Tour Series is a pair of 5ths, both this season (Austin and Fort Lauderdale)
- This year Webber played two international events with Miles Evans, and they went from the qualifier to claiming a silver medal in Rhodes, Greece in May
