

## Atlanta – Stadium Court Notes – Saturday, August 6, 2022 – Match 7

### 5:00pm – #2 Tri Bourne / Trevor Crabb vs. #4 Taylor Crabb / Taylor Sander

#### Head to Head

- This is the first meeting between the teams
  - The Crabb brothers were partners for 12 AVP tournaments (3 seconds, 6 thirds) as well as 5 FIVB events (best of 9th place 4 times)
  - This will be the 18th meeting between the two brothers... Taylor has a 9-8 advantage (Taylor 8-6 on the AVP Tour and Trevor 2-1 on the FIVB Tour)
    - Taylor has eliminated Trevor in 4 tournaments, including once in an AVP final (Hermosa Beach 2017), once in Austin (2018) and once on the FIVB Tour.... Trevor has eliminated Taylor 4 times, including in their most recent 3 meetings
  - Bourne has a 9-7 advantage over Taylor Crabb in their previous meetings... Bourne has an 8-5 advantage on the AVP Tour... overall Bourne has won 5 of the last 6 meetings

**Bourne / Trevor Crabb** are playing together for the 16th time on the AVP Tour and 44th time overall... they have 3 AVP wins (Long Beach 2020 event #3, Manhattan Beach 2021, Fort Lauderdale 2022) and 1 FIVB win (Qinzhou 2018)

- Bourne was 8-0 vs Trevor Crabb on the AVP Tour, while Trevor Crabb was 1-0 vs Bourne on the FIVB Tour
- In their first 2 events this year they were seeded first, the first time ever the pair has been seeded #1 on the AVP Tour
- In 5 seasons as partners on the AVP, they are 48-23 (68%) in matches, 42-4 (91%) when winning the first set, 6-19 (24%) when losing the first set, and 16-8 (67%) in three-set matches
- Last year in Atlanta the duo was 3rd, and all 5 of their matches went three sets

**Tri Bourne** – age 33 – 6’5” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Southern Cal

- This is Bourne’s 37th AVP event... he has played with just 3 partners in his career (with just one event with Raffe Paulis, the remainder with John Hyden and Crabb)
- He has won 6 times, placed 2nd 7 times, and placed 3rd 13 times... he has advanced to the semifinals in 26 of his 36 completed AVP events (72% of the tournaments entered)
- Bourne has advanced to the semifinals in 26 of his last 32 AVP tournaments

**Trevor Crabb** – age 32 – 6’4” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i. – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Puget Sound / Long Beach State

- Trevor Crabb is playing in his 53rd AVP Tournament, with 4 wins, 8 second-place finishes, and 15 third-place finishes... his first 3 wins came in California before winning in Florida
- Crabb and Casey Patterson are the only players to have reached the semifinals in each of the past 9 years (2014-2022)

**Taylor Crabb / Sander** are playing together for the 5th time on the AVP Tour and 9th time overall

- Duo placed 5th in their AVP debut in Austin, then 2nd in New Orleans and Hermosa Beach before finishing 3rd in Fort Lauderdale
- In 1 season as partners on the AVP, they are 15-7 (68%) in matches, 11-2 (85%) when winning the first set, 4-5 (44%) when losing the first set, and 5-4 (56%) in three-set matches
- They began the season with an 11-3 match record, but since then have gone 4-4

**Taylor Crabb** – age 30 – 6’0” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Long Beach State

- This is Crabb’s 45th AVP event with his 5th different partner
- Crabb has 8 wins (all with Jake Gibb), 11 seconds (with 3 different partners), and 13 thirds

- Crabb led the AVP Tour in victories in 2019 with 4, but has not won since then (Honolulu 2019)

**Taylor Sander – age 30 – 6'5" – hometown Corona, Calif. – currently Huntington Beach, Calif. – Brigham Young**

- Austin marked his AVP debut... on the AVP Tour he has a career 15-7 match record with 6 of the losses coming against teams seeded first or second and coming against teams with at least one beach Olympian
