

Austin – Stadium Court Notes – Sunday, May 8, 2022 – Match 2

10:10 am – #1 Tri Bourne / Trevor Crabb vs. #7 Taylor Crabb / Taylor Sander

Head to Head

- This is the first meeting between the teams
 - The Crabb brothers were partners for 12 AVP tournaments (3 seconds, 6 thirds) as well as 5 FIVB events (best of 9th place 4 times)
 - This will be the 16th meeting between the two brothers... Taylor has a 9-6 advantage (Taylor 8 -4 on the AVP Tour and Trevor 2-1 on the FIVB Tour)
 - Taylor has eliminated Trevor in 4 tournaments, including once in an AVP final (Hermosa Beach 2017), once in Austin (2018) and once on the FIVB Tour.... Trevor has eliminated Taylor 2 times, including in their most recent meeting in Manhattan Beach 2021
 - Bourne and Taylor Crabb have split their 14 previous meetings... Bourne has a 6-5 advantage on the AVP Tour... overall Bourne has won 3 of the last 4 meetings

Bourne / Trevor Crabb are playing together for the 13th time on the AVP Tour and 36th time overall... they have 2 AVP wins (Long Beach 2020 event #3 and Manhattan Beach 2021) and 1 FIVB win (Qinzhou 2018)

- Bourne was 8-0 vs Trevor Crabb on the AVP Tour, while Trevor Crabb was 1-0 vs Bourne on the FIVB Tour
- Austin marks the first time ever the pair has been seeded #1 on the AVP Tour
- In 5 seasons as partners on the AVP, they are 39-19 (67.2%) in matches, 33-3 (91.7%) when winning the first set, 6-16 (27.3%) when losing the first set, and 15-6 (71.4%) in three-set matches

Tri Bourne – age 32 – 6’5” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Southern Cal

- This is Bourne’s 34th AVP event... he has won 5 times, placed 2nd 7 times, and placed 3rd 12 times... he has advanced to the semifinals in 24 of his 33 completed AVP events (73% of the tournaments entered)
- Bourne has advanced to the semifinals in 24 of his last 29 AVP tournaments

Trevor Crabb – age 32 – 6’4” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i. – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Puget Sound / Long Beach State

- Trevor Crabb is playing in his 50th AVP Tournament, with 3 wins, 8 second-place finishes, and 14 third-place finishes
- Crabb joins Jake Gibb (recently retired) and Casey Patterson as the only players to have reached the semifinals in each of the past 8 years (2014-2021)

Taylor Crabb / Sander are playing together for the 1st time on the AVP Tour and 3rd time overall

- Duo placed 9th and then 25th in their two international events prior to making their AVP debut here

Taylor Crabb – age 30 – 6’0” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Long Beach State

- This is Crabb’s 41st AVP event with his 5th different partner
- Crabb has 8 wins (all with Jake Gibb), 9 seconds (with 3 different partners), and 12 thirds
- Crabb led the AVP Tour in victories in 2019 with 4, but has not won since then (Honolulu 2019)

Taylor Sander – age 30 – hometown Corona, Calif. – currently Hermosa Beach, Calif. – Brigham Young

- After competing in the 2016 and 2020 Olympics with the USA Indoor Team, Sander made his pro beach volleyball debut in November 2021
- Austin marks his AVP debut
