

## Manhattan Beach – Stadium Court Notes – Sunday, Aug. 22, 2021 – Match 2

### 10:05 am – #2 Taylor Crabb / Jake Gibb vs #4 Tri Bourne / Trevor Crabb

#### Head to Head

- Taylor Crabb / Gibb lead the series 6-3, but Bourne / Trevor Crabb have won 2 of the last 3... 4 times the match went to a third set (Taylor Crabb / Gibb 3-1 in those)
- With any partners, Taylor Crabb leads the series 9-5 against Trevor Crabb, who has won 2 of the last 3

**Taylor Crabb / Gibb** are playing together for the 23rd time on the AVP Tour and for the 56th time overall... The pair has won 8 AVP titles and 1 FIVB title

- In their partnership on the AVP Tour, they are 87-25 (77.7%) in matches, 75-7 (91.5%) when winning the first set, 10-18 (35.7%) when losing the first set, and 20-10 (66.7%) in three-set matches
- The duo placed 2nd in Manhattan Beach 2018, their last time playing here

#### Taylor Crabb – age 29 – 6’0” – hometown Honolulu – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Long Beach State

- This is Taylor Crabb’s 39th AVP event, and he has won 8 AVP titles plus 1 FIVB win (all with Gibb)... he has advanced to the semifinals 29 times in his career (76% of the tournaments) and has reached the semifinals in 28 of his last 31 AVP tournaments
- In 2020, Taylor Crabb tied for the Tour lead in digs per set (5.5) and was 5th in hitting percentage (.422)

#### Jake Gibb – age 45 – 6’7” – hometown Bountiful, Utah – currently Huntington Beach, Calif. – Utah

- Gibb is playing in his 164th AVP Tournament, with 34 AVP wins plus 7 FIVB wins... Gibb has won with 5 different partners... He is the only player who has won multiple AVP titles in each of the 7 seasons from 2013 to 2019
- In 2020, Gibb was 2nd on the Tour in blocks per set (1.9) and in aces (0.8)
- Gibb has won 3 times in Manhattan Beach with 3 different partners (Stein Metzger 2005, Sean Rosenthal 2009, Casey Patterson 2016)

**Bourne / Trevor Crabb** are playing together for the 11th time on the AVP Tour and 32nd time overall... they have 1 AVP win (Long Beach 2020 event #3) and 1 FIVB win

- Bourne was 8-0 vs Trevor Crabb on the AVP Tour, while Trevor Crabb was 1-0 vs Bourne on the FIVB Tour
- In 2020 they had an 8-4 match record, with 2 losses against top seeds Phil Dalhausser / Nick Lucena and 2 losses against #2 seeds Taylor Crabb / Jake Gibb
- In their AVP partnership, the duo is 30-17 (63.8%) in matches, 26-3 (89.7%) when winning the first set, 4-14 (22.2%) when losing the first set, and 13-6 (68.4%) in three-set matches
- In Atlanta all 5 of their matches went to a third set but so far in Manhattan Beach just 1 of 3 matches went three sets

#### Tri Bourne – age 32 – 6’5” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Southern Cal

- This is Bourne’s 33rd AVP event... he has won 4 times, placed 2nd 6 times, and placed 3rd 13 times... he has advanced to the semifinals in 22 of his previous 31 AVP events (71% of the tournaments entered)
- In 2020 Bourne ranked 3rd on the Tour in hitting percentage (.429) and 4th in kills (7.35 per set)
- Bourne finished 2nd in Manhattan Beach twice before (2015 and 2016 with John Hyden)

#### Trevor Crabb – age 31 – 6’4” – hometown Honolulu, Hawai’i. – currently Redondo Beach, Calif. – Puget Sound / Long Beach State

- Trevor Crabb is playing in his 48th AVP Tournament, with 2 wins, 7 second-place finishes, and 14 third-place finishes
- Trevor Crabb is the defending Manhattan Beach champion, having won in 2019 with Reid Priddy... he also finished 2nd with Sean Rosenthal in 2017
